- 2. **Odors** Compliance for Emissions & Odors 239-344-5673. Renee Kwait is the contact person. Leave a message. Don't forget to mention Leisure Lakes facilities and "Covered Bridge", your name, address, and phone number. Someone should call you back.

#### <u>ARCHITECURAL</u> <u>COMMITTEE</u>

There seems to be a fair amount of uncertainty as to what a resident can do to their home, without architectural committee approval, and paperwork. The quick and easy answer is to ask a member of the committee. The members are:

The Architectural Committee was created, and duties established in article VI (d) of the original declaration of covenants for Covered Bridge in the conception of our HOA, back in 1975. The latest architectural committee rules were last updated in May 2022.

The purpose of the committee is to maintain Covered Bridge properties at a high level of appearance and in accordance with current county building regulations.

Upcoming architectural committee articles in the Echoes will include residential painting, carports, driveway widening, patios, screen rooms, lawn plantings, re-roofing, solar panels, easements and property lines, the need of building permits and other pertinent items under the guidelines and rules of the architectural committee.

It should be noted that the Architectural Committee does not enforce the rules and regulations. We are to advise and ensure that the resident's property modification proposal meets them. If the committee turns down the proposal, the resident can then present the proposal to the board of directors for their decision whether it is approved or rejected.
